Subject: Assessment of the Students of Classes K.G. to H for the Academic Session 2021-22.

Due to Covid-19 pandemic, the face-to-face interaction in the classroom teaching and learning activities in the schools had to be suspended. To mitigate the academic loss, the project 'Online Classes' was initiated with the approval of the Competent Authority vide which online/ offline worksheets were provided to the students of classes Nursery to V since July 2020. The same approach was being adopted during this session i.e. 2021-22 as well, till opening of the schools on 14/02/2022. The schools are now open for all classes and all the initiatives including 'Reading Campaign' are being covered through face-to-face interaction in the classroom.

To consolidate & map the learning outcomes achieved in the Academic Session 2021-22, it becomes imperative that the response of the students is graded. A circular regarding assessment guidelines for classes III to V has already been issued by Exam Branch. As regards K.G. to class 2 (where no formal examination is undertaken), the students will be given grades on the basis of the following:

- a) Winter Vacation Assignments given vide Circular No. DE/30/Nur.Pry.Br/ RCM/2018/PF-5/277 dated 27/12/2021.
- b) Responses to online/ offline worksheets shared with the students during current Academic Session.
- c) Oral practice of the Reading Campaign worksheets through face-to-face interaction in the classroom.

All the currently enrolled students of classes Nursery to II shall be promoted to the next higher class under the No Detention Policy (NDP) as per RTE Act, 2009 in the Academic Session 2021-22. However, the purpose of this assessment is to understand the impact of alternate learning approach that needed to be adopted under the prevailing circumstances. Further, the data of this assessment will also help the Directorate of Education in determining the course content and learning strategies for the next session.

Heads of schools are directed to follow the guidelines mentioned above at their own

level in respect of classes K.G. to II. All the safety measures regarding Covid-19 should be strictly followed.
